2/06/2016 – First Practice Test

2/13/2016 – First Lecture

- Intro: We will go over the test format and discuss the changes from the old version
- Reading Intro: We will take a look at the structure of the reading passages and establish the strategies for dealing with the passages. We will also discuss pacing for the section.
- Writing & Language Intro: We will introduce the Writing & Language Section and review some of the major grammar rules tested. We will finally talk about pacing for this section.
