Description

This class will be an introduction to the Chinese language and culture for students age 6-8.

Expectations and Goals

By the end of the year, students should have a good foundation for the Chinese language. They will be able to recognize characters and hold basic conversations, such as introducing themselves, recognizing date/time, and talking about where they are going. The students will practice writing and reading both pinyin and characters. There will also be lessons on certain Chinese holidays and cultures.

You can purchase the textbook in the office (Room IRN131). The textbook is called LangLang Chinese Elementary 1A Textbook. It comes with two workbooks which we will get our homework from. Students are expected to bring their own pencils and other writing materials to class.

Those resources are in no way required, but if you feel like your child would like additional practice, it is a good resource to have on hand.
