HOPE CHINESE SCHOOL RULES OF BEHAVIOR

STUDENTS COME TO SCHOOL FOR AN EDUCATION. NO ONE HAS THE RIGHT TO INTERFERE WITH THE EDUCATION OF OTHERS

- Getting an education requires more than merely being in class. Students are expected to actively participate in their learning.
- A teacher should not have to delay class because a student has come late or unprepared to begin work. This interferes with the rights of others to learn and study.
- Obey school rules. Rules are designed to ensure schools and classrooms are learning environments where students are safe and successful. Students have a responsibility to obey these rules so each student has the proper environment in which to learn.

ALL STUDENTS IN HCS HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY TO:

- Respect the rights of others to study and learn.
- Respect CGCC property. No food and drinks are allowed in any classrooms. Students are not allowed to touch classroom equipment such as telephones, computers, projectors and alarm system. Any one that prank calls 911 will be responsible for a \$500 fine as penalty. Anyone damaging CGCC property will be responsible for the cost for the damage and will be disciplined.
- Be on time for all classes. Students who enter a classroom after a class has begun are interfering with the rights of others to learn and study.
- Complete all in-class and homework assignments, and meet deadlines.
- Come to class with necessary books and materials.

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS:

- Students involved in inappropriate behavior are subject to the below disciplinary actions. Depending upon the nature of the problem with the student, one or more of the following actions may be taken by school officials. Misconduct can also result in expulsion.
 - Informal Talk.
 - Parent Involvement.
 - In School Discipline.
 - Temporary Suspension. Short or Long.
 - Expulsion.
